
The project:

As our volunteer you can have an insight into the work of a civil organization and showcase your talents.



The ideal volunteer is:

- open-minded and **empathetic** towards the different target groups
- proactive in coming up with ideas relating to the target groups
- flexible and **able to adapt** to new situations
- comfortable working both independently and in a team
- **comfortable performing** in front of an audience
- fluent in **English**



Your tasks will be:

- Sharing your culture through singing
- Teaching simple songs, rhymes, and musical games
- Crafting simple instruments from recyclable materials

- Giving presentations about your country's culture and traditions in schools and elderly clubs

- Administration, office work
- Posting on social media

Playing an instrument is a great plus!



Worktime

Work is from Monday to Friday, from 10 am to 4 pm. Weekends, as well as national holidays are free. Each month you will have 2 days off. The place of work is either the office of the Talentum or any other institution we visit.



Accommodation

For the volunteers, we will provide accommodation. The flat is on the 9th floor of a ten-storey house (with an elevator) with a scenic view to a park and a lake. There are two separate bedrooms, an equipped kitchen and a washing machine in the bathroom. Hair dryer, bed linen and towels are all provided for. Supermarkets and public transport are close by and easily accessible. The flat is 15 minutes from the city centre by public transport.

Support

Volunteers will receive pocket money and monthly allowance for food and livelihood. You will also receive a public transport monthly pass. Travel costs are covered under a limit defined by the European Solidarity Corps and our volunteers will receive free HENNER health insurance.




Location: Szeged

Szeged is a regional center in the South Plain Region of Hungary as the third biggest town of the country, located 160 km from Budapest.
